The Source: A Guidebook of American Cencalo(y, call no.R929.1072, has been added to the Genealory Collec-tion at the County Library. This book has been compiled by 16 leading (encalogists and describes many important record sources from Colonial Times to the present. Of note are the addresses of some of the major businesses and institutions, a copy of the overnment publication Where to Write for Birth, Death, Marriage and Divorce Records, and lists of Societies. The chapter on computers, and computer programs and databases available for genealogists should be read if you are looking into computers for Genealogy. Some of the databases described are in use in the states of Illincis, entucky, Louisiana, Missouri, Ceorgia, So. Carolina and Tonnessee.
