SOUTHERN RESEARCH

Do you have a gap or missing link in your early southern line? If you do you should read "Spanish Records: Locating Anglo and Latin Ancestry in the Colonial Southeast" in the December 1985 issue of the "National Genealogical Society Quarterly." Many settlers from New England and the Atlantic colonies moved into the area that was controlled by Spain, some temporarily and some permanently. The Spanish officials were meticulous record keepers and more and more of their extensive records are becoming available for research.

NATIONAL ARCHIVES

The May/June 1986 issue of the "National Genealogical Society Newsletter" contained the first of twelve in a series of articles about the National Archives Field Branches. The first article was an overview of the general holdings of the archives and articles about the individual branches will be in the next eleven issues of the Newsletter.
