# IN THE MAIL THIS MONTH

The Montana State Genealogical Society is going to publish a cookbook as a fund raiser. The book will feature recipes handed down by our ancestors. If you have a recipe that you would like to see include in this cookbook plese bring a ledgible copy of it and a short history of the recipe to the next meeting. You can also mail your recipes to Florance Magstaff, P.O. Box 823, Billings MT 59103. The recipes can be in all catagories. Last month I forgot to include the recipe for Kartoffel (potato dumplings), a traditional recipe used by the Germans from Russia, that came with this announcement. Mix together: 6 c. grated potatoes, 6 T. sweet cream, 1 tsp. baking powder, 1 tsp. salt, and 1/2 cup of flour.Roll by hand to about the size of a walnut. Drop each dumpling in boiling, salted water. Boil until done. Drain, pour white sauce over dumplings and serve.

### FAMILY HISTORY LIBRARY

The <u>new computer sytem</u> for looking at the IGI, FAMILY ANCESTRAL FILES and the Library Catalogue is up and running!!! This is a great tool and allows for printouts at only 5 cents/page. The IGI for all of the USA and Canada are all intermixed so searches here can be time consuming. Use of the IGI on the fiche may be more time economical if you know what state you want. If you bring your own MSDOS formatted disk you can download information for use at home with this program or with compatible word processors. Blank disks are available at the family history center for \$1.00 each.

<u>City Directories</u> on microfiche from all over the US are pouring into the library faster than they can be put into the files! Some go back as far as the late 1790's (NY, Boston), but most are from around the 1850's. There are too many to list, but most of the larger cities are included. We will try to get a complete listing when they have all arrived.
