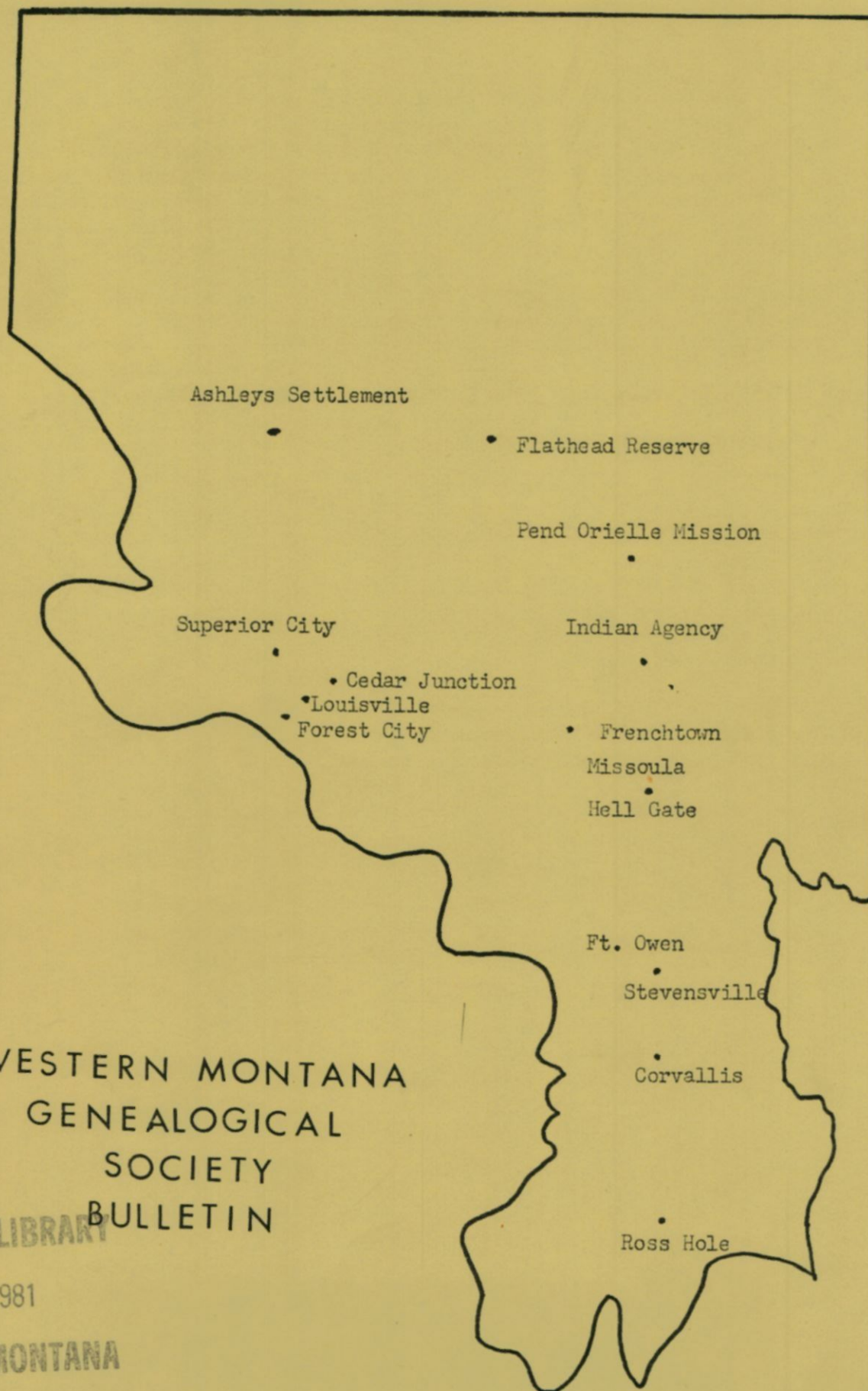

COMPLETE LIST OF THE VOTERS AT THE FIRST TERRITORIAL ELECTION HELD IN THE
TERRITORY OF MONTANA ON THE 24TH OF OCTOBER 1864.

These lists have been carefully compiled from the original poll lists on file in the Secretary of State's Office in Helena by the Secretary of State for the Society of Montana Pioneers. The transcription was dated September 19, 1904. The Secretary of State, Geo. M. Hays, states that the names are "correct as nearly as can be deciphered from the old records."
