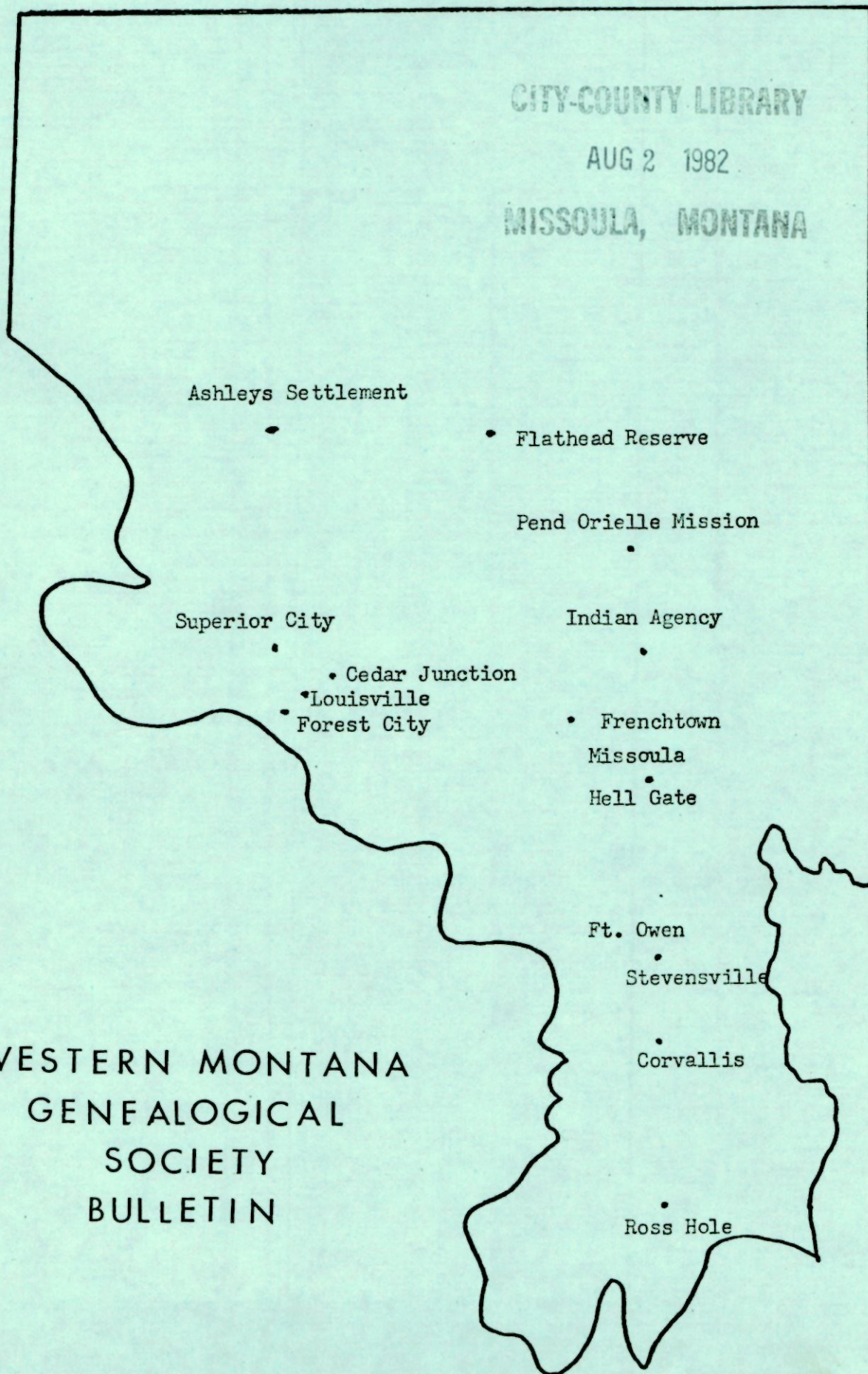

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"A ROUND MISSOULA"

NATIONAL ARCHIVES SHUTS DOWN FORT WORTH MICROFILM LOAN PROGRAM

No more census microfilms. What a blow to genealogical research, not only in Missoula, but throughout the whole country. National Archivist, Robert Warner, explained the rationale for closing the Fort Worth operation: "The Archives has been hit with a funding reduction and ordered to cut staff by 181 full-time positions by February of 1982. Even if staff were increased, we could not keep up with the current demand, and it's thus better to close up shop now." The Archives was handling over 400,000 reels annually with 35,000 rolls of film a month. Henderson surmises that more than 50 percent of the users are genealogists and the rest scholars.

There is a possibility that a private contractor could pick up this service. A recent announcement in the FEDERAL REGISTER tested receptivity to the idea and found a good response in the private sector. The next step is to put out a formal Request for Proposal. The federal budget squeeze will make access to federal information not as convenient or as free according to Carol Henderson, Washington Representative of the American Library Association.

Other alternatives to obtaining census microfilms: Purchase them at \$15.00 per roll, or order them from Salt Lake City through the Branch Genealogical Library. Many have expressed the idea that they liked to order through the public library as their hours offered more flexibility for them to read the microfilm. If more people use the Branch Library, perhaps their staff could be enlarged and the library open more hours to accommodate the public's need.

MISSOULA COUNTY INDEX

Mrs. Audra Browman, (664 South Sixth East, Missoula MT 59801; 406-543-7475) has compiled an index to early Missoula County records listing people living in Western Montana in the territorial days. Records include; newspapers, land claim records to 1893 but not sales of land, mining and water rights to 1896, the first few rights in new mining areas and streams from 1886-1890, results of local elections, early notices of births, deaths, and marriages published in the newspapers, the 1860, 1870, and 1880 census records.

The information is on separate cards for each individual with references to the sources where information is found about that individual, not the information. The cards are currently at her home and she will gladly search her files for those sending a self-addressed stamped envelope with their inquiry. Eventually the information will be given to the Mansfield Library, Archives and Special Collections, University of Montana, Missoula.
