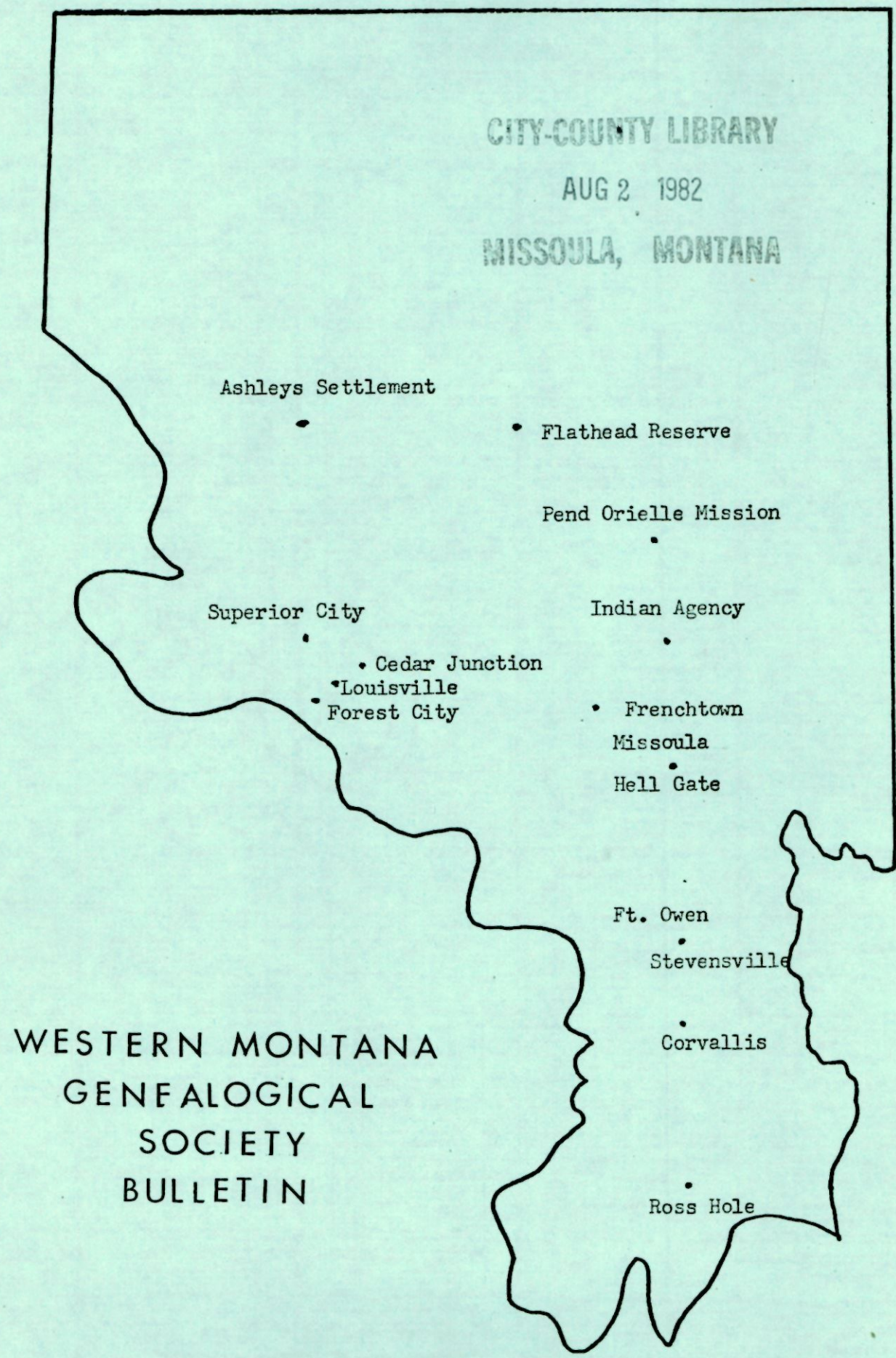

Julia Maranda Jane Gillmore was born in the year of our Lord 1850 Nov 1st.

George Washington Gillmore was born in the year of our Lord 1852 June 24th.

Ambrose Lenert Gillmore was born in the year of our Lord 1853 Sept 25th.

Olover James Gillmore was born in the year of our Lord 1855 July 2nd.

Angeline Harriette Gillmore was born in the year of our Lord 1857 Feb 18th.

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#### HISTORICAL CHRONOLOGY OF MISSOULA COUNTY by Dennis L. Richards

- 1805      Lewis and Clark explore the Missoula area.
- 1812      David Thompson climbs Mt. Jumbo and maps the surrounding country.
- 1841      St. Mary's Mission, the first in Montana for the Indians, was established by Father DeSmet, thirty miles south of Missoula at Stevensville.
- 1843      Region now comprising Missoula County was part of the Clackamas District in Oregon.
- 1849      Oregon Territory created by Congress.
- 1850      John Owen establishes Ft. Owen trading post at previously abandoned St. Mary's Mission.
- 1853      Region was now part of the newly created Washington Territory and Clarke County changes spelling to Clark.
- 1854      St. Ignatius Mission established.
- 1858      The area was now part of the newly created Spokane County.
- 1860      Frank L. Worden and C.P. Higgins opened their store at Hell Gate. On Dec 14, all of Washington Territory between 115 longitude and the main ridge of the Rockies was designated as Missoula County with the county seat at Hell Gate which was located six miles west of the present site of Missoula. The village of Frenchtown was started 12 miles west of the present site of Missoula.
- 1861      Montana's first county election held at Hell Gate.
- 1863      Missoula County made part of the newly created Idaho Territory. Mullen Road from Walla Walla to Ft. Benton was completed. First church for whites was built at Hell Gate and named St. Michael's after the Catholic saint who guards the gates of Hell.



- 1864 Montana Territory was organized. Vigilantes hang members of Sheriff Plummer's outlaw gang at Hell Gate. Worden, Higgins and Pattee erected a sawmill and gristmill east of Hell Gate in what is now Missoula.
- 1865 Higgins and Worden moved their store from Hell Gate to the new location called Missoula Mills, later shortened to Missoula. In September a county election was held and newly elected officers organized the Missoula County government and for the first time official records were kept.
- 1866 County seat was moved to Missoula and Hell Gate was abandoned. The first jail was built. An overland stage and horseback route was established for mail and the Post Office was opened.
- 1869 Discovery of gold on Cedar Creek 70 miles west of Missoula. First public school opened with Emma Slack Dickinson as teacher.
- 1871 The MISSOULA AND CEDAR CREEK PIONEER, the first newspaper in the county was started and later renamed the MISSOULIAN. The Episcopal Church started in Missoula.
- 1872 The Methodist Church started in Missoula.
- 1873 St. Francis Xavier was founded in Missoula (Catholic).
- 1876 The Presbyterian Church started in Missoula.
- 1877 A military post named Ft. Missoula was established.
- 1883 Missoula incorporated as a town. The construction of the Northern Pacific Railroad through Missoula was completed.
- 1885 The Disciples of Christ Church started in Missoula.
- 1889 Missoula was incorporated as a city and Montana became a state.
- 1890 The Baptist Church started in Missoula.
- 1893 The Lutheran Church (Missouri Synod) began in Missoula. In February the northern part of the county became Flathead County and the southern part of the county became Ravalli County.
- 1894 The Missoula Public Library opened.
- 1895 The University of Montana began with 50 students.
- 1898 The Lutheran Church began in Missoula.
- 1905 Sanders County was created from the extreme western portion of Missoula County in March.
- 1908 The Regional U.S. Forest Service Office was established in Missoula.



- 1914 Mineral County broke off from Missoula County in August.  
 1923 Lake County was separated from Missoula County in August.  
 1979 The Western Montana Genealogical Society was organized in September.
