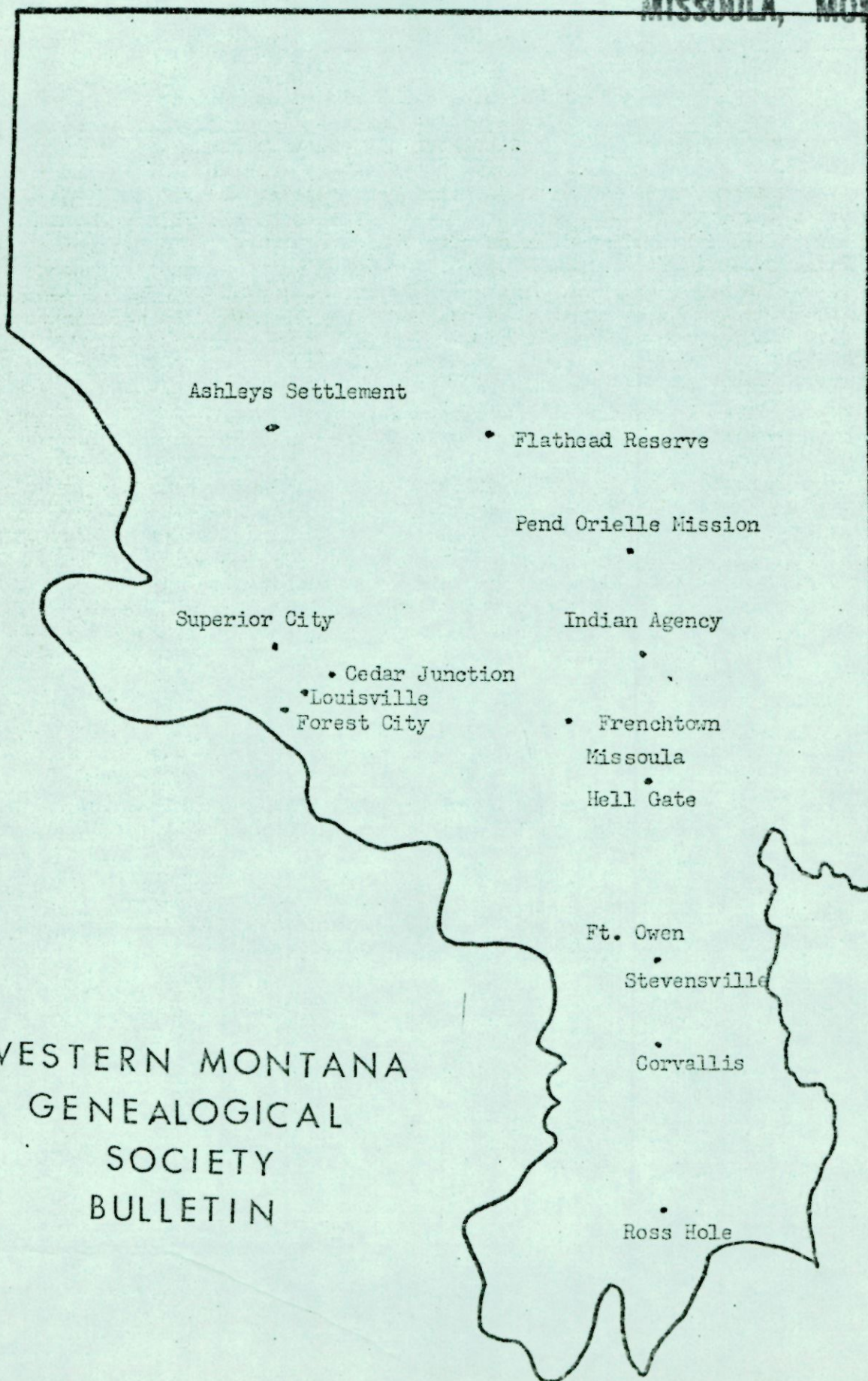

Dennis Richards has a sample copy of vol. 1, no. 4 (February 15, 1983) if anyone would like to examine it. It contains genealogical articles, book reviews. Most of the issue is advertisements for ancestors, p. 7 to 20. Surname section gives the following: ancestor's name, birth year and state, marriage year and state and spouse followed by a code. Under contributors, code numbers are listed numerically beginning with 1000 and gives the following: name, address, city, state, and zipcode.

MISSOULA COUNTY DEATH AND BURIAL RECORDS INDEX PROJECT

Beginning last Fall, the Society members decided that our Missoula Centennial project would be to compile and index Missoula's death and burial records. We started with the present Missoula County boundaries and then plan to extend the project to eventually include all of the original Missoula County boundaries.

First we transcribed information off of tombstones. To date we have compiled the Carlton Cemetery, the Fort Missoula Post Cemetery, the Frenchtown Cemetery and almost completed the Missoula City Cemetery last Fall. Approximately 40 hours of transcription time remain to be done. We also have the Catholic Cemetery (St. Mary's and St. Mary's Annex) and Sunset Memorial Gardens.

Second, we began indexing the vital records from the Missoulian including births, marriages, divorces and deaths shortly after the organization of the Society. We have completed 1900-1909 and the Missoula Public Library staff has indexed the obituaries from the Missoulian from 1976-1983. The Society members will continue indexing to bridge the gap between 1910 and 1975 and before 1900.

Third, we will compare the information from the tombstones and obituaries information kept in the cemetery offices, the mortuaries and the Missoula County records if possible.

Most of the above records are not indexed and are therefore difficult to use. One must know the year of death to check cemetery records and the exact date of death for newspaper obituaries. Many people living outside the Missoula area do not know this information about their ancestors and have difficulty in trying to use these sources. We are also compiling an alphabetical name index which will give birth and death dates, name of cemetery and town of burial.

When all of the above information is gathered we would like to apply for a grant to have it computerized. We would like to see other groups in the State take on such projects in their local areas so that by the State's Centennial, death and burial information would be centrally compiled for the entire State.

Maurice Helterline is compiling death and burial information for Sanders Co. and in this issue of the Bulletin is his first listing of "Burials in the Plains-Paradise Valley before 1900." He is doing an excellent job and we look forward to including the remainder of his work in our BULLETIN as it is completed.

It hardly seems enough to just say thanks to those who have spent so much time in the above mentioned projects. We really appreciate what you have done and we have been able to make good use of what has been done so far. We are really looking forward to the day when the project will be completed. Hope that you can continue to help us so faithfully this Spring and Summer as you have last fall.
